



The Netherlands' assistance to Ukraine

 2022-2025

i For international emergency relief we provide unearmarked, multi-annual funding to international organizations such as OCHA, UNHCR, UNICEF and ICRC, part of which will be used to support Ukraine.

Budget support € 4.6 billion

Financial support to the Ukrainian government to support the national budget of Ukraine. For example to pay salaries of:

- Hospital staff
- Teachers and civil servants

Recovery and Reconstruction € 1.1 billion

To support the reconstruction of critical infrastructure, also through the private sector, in the following areas:

- Energy
- Water, agriculture, transport, and social infrastructure
- Health care systems

Emergency aid and Protection € 172.3 million

To support aid organizations to:

- Provide food, shelter, medicine, and protection for Ukrainians.
- Implement demining action
- Increase better access to quality Mental Health and Psychological and Social Support (MPSS)

Accountability € 71 million

The Netherlands leads international accountability efforts against war crimes and impunity by contributing to:

- The possible establishment of an aggression tribunal and a compensation mechanism
- Supporting Ukrainian and international investigation and prosecution of war crimes



Committed non-military support

€ 6 billion

€ 200 million in *loans*
€ 3.3 billion in *guarantees*
€ 2.5 billion in *grants*

Total committed to Ukraine

€ 17.1 billion

This includes the Dutch contribution to the European Peace Facility (€ 670 million).

Committed military support

€ 10.4 billion

of which € 5.88 billion has been delivered to Ukraine
